## FROM OUR MINISTER

Dear Friends,

It seems time is moving very fast, we just had Christmas, now we are standing at the edge of Lent. The time of the year when as Disciples of Christ we are invited to take stock of our lives and spend time deepening our relationship with God.



For us the Lenten period is a sacred journey of remembering the love of Christ. It is a time when we seek to understand the fullness of Christ's offering on the Cross and the power of His resurrection.

The Lantern journey has three main themes for Christians to consider, prayer, fasting and almsgiving. These items are designed to help us examine three areas of our lives.

Prayer helps us look again at our relationship with God and ask, is this relationship a vital, living part of our daily life? Prayer creates a space for us to enter the stillness with the God of love. It is imperative that we spend time with God.

Fasting helps us look at how we are using the resources of the world around us. To say we give up chocolates, sweets, wine and so on without clear purpose trivialises Lent. When we fast, our action must encourage us to do better things, such as giving to those in need and improving our relationship with God through Bible studies and Fellowship groups. For instance, we are going to have Lent Sessions at Ashford Common and Laleham Methodist Churches to explore the joy of living simply, while joining in solidarity with our global neighbours.

Almsgiving is a sign of generosity. It often results from prayers and fasting. The closer we come to God the closer we are drawn together and to each other.

This Lantern pilgrimage is a significant journey. We travel together as the Body of Christ from Ash Wednesday to the Crucifixion and finally to the joy of Easter Morning. As we read the scriptures and pray we encounter the Lord Jesus, the Apostles and the High Priest. We also

meet the Pharisees, the Scribes, Pilate, the Roman Soldiers and the sinners who were healed. All these people have so much to teach us about other peoples' suffering as well as our own suffering, pain, hurts and faith.

Perhaps the most significant action we can take is to cooperate with the Holy Spirit, who is with us every step of our journey, helping us to confront the big questions of meaning and commitment to our faith in Jesus Christ.

I leave you with two questions, what type of activities do you intend to undertake that engage your whole heart? Of the three Lenten disciplines prayer, fasting and almsgiving, which one do you feel is important for you?

May this season of Lent help you to grow in your discipleship as you experience His presence

A number of possibilities need to be considered and the issues will be looked at when the Circuit Meeting takes place on the 1<sup>st</sup> March.

On the 28<sup>th</sup> January the final Service took place at Christ Church and I would like to thank everyone who prepared for the Service and to thank those who came along to share in what was a very special time. We continue to remember the congregation as they settle in their new fellowships.

On the other side of the Circuit, you might like to know that Father Mark Ewbank is leaving St Jude's in April 2018 and Mrs. Jayne Watson is leaving the Village Centre at Englefield Green. We wish them well in their new appointments.
